A distillery preserved...



For a general overview of the business of distilling you could do worse than make for the Dallas Dhu distillery on the outskirts of Forres.

The picture above maintains a link to an earlier owner – the Benmore Distilleries Ltd – who operated the distillery during the 1920s and eventually sold out to DCL (the Distillers Company) in 1928.

Since its eventual closure in 1983, partly because of difficulties with the water supply, the distillery has been maintained as a museum of distilling by Historic Scotland (aka Historic Environment Scotland).

There is an audio visual presentation and an audio guide, as well as a well stocked shop.

The Brora distillery, which actually started life as the Clynelish distillery way back in 1819, changed its name to Brora in 1968 when its close neighbour, the present Clynelish distillery opened for business.

Renowned for its peaty character, the

whisky ceased to flow from the stills in 1983, when the distillery closed its doors.

However in late 2017, owners Diageo announced that the distillery would come back to life some time during 2020.

Clyenlish is one of the eight distilleries participating in the Highland Whisky Festival, others being Balblair, Glenmorangie, Old Pulteney, The Dalmore, The Singleton of Glen Ord, Tomatin and Wolfburn.




